DAY 1: SAT 30 MAY Depart Australia

Depart Australia on our Thai Airways flights to Bangkok. On arrival, proceed to our connecting El Al flight bound for Tel Aviv.

DAY 2: SUN 31 MAY

Arrive Tel Aviv, Jaffa, Bethlehem, Shepherds Fields

After our morning arrival into Ben Gurion Airport we will meet our guide and driver. We will visit the ancient seaport city of Jaffa before heading to Bethlehem, where King David was born. Bethlehem means a "city of Bread" and it was so called because of the rich wheat harvest in the region. We will also visit Manger Square, the place where Jesus Christ was placed after birth. After a view of Shepherds Fields and a short visit to the church, we return to the city of Jerusalem where we will have dinner and overnight. (B,D)

This evening will be the start of the Empowered 21 conference at the Pais Arena.

DAY 3: MON 1 JUNE

City of David, Mt of Olives, Gethsemane, Old City, Mt Scopus War Cemetery

After breakfast we will walk through sections of the City of David and through Hezekiah's Tunnels, the very site where Jerusalem first became Israel's capital. Then we visit the Mt of Olives for a breathtaking view of the Holy City before we begin the descent down the Palm Sunday walk to Dominus Flevit where Yeshua wept over the city. Further down we will come to the Gethsemane private garden where He agonised in prayer just prior to His arrest. We then enter the Old City to the Pools of Bethesda where Yeshua healed the crippled man, and afterwards take a short walk to Ecce Homo, the place where Pilate presented Yeshua after His scourging. From that point we will walk the Via Dolorosa and then continue to Mt. Zion and the Upper Room before finishing the day at the Mt Scopus War Memorial Cemetery where many of the ANZACs are buried. DAY 4: TUE 2 JUNE E21

DAY 6: THU 4 JUNE

Israel Museum, Yad Vashem, Jewish Quarter

We begin our day at the Israel Museum to see the scale of model of Jerusalem as it was in Yeshua's days. We also see the famous Dead Sea Scrolls and visit the nearby Yad Vashem Holocaust Museum, which is very sobering but incredibly important. There are a

growing number of voices around the world denying the holocaust ever happened and it is important that we never, ever forget the truth. We then head back to the Old City to walk to the Southern Steps that led into the Temple, and see the many mikvot (ritual baths) used by the Jews for cleansing, and sit on the very steps where Yeshua taught. We will continue to the Western Wall (Wailing Wall), sacred to Jews for the past 2000 years, and where they pray daily facing the site where the Temple (Holy of Holies) used to stand. (B,D)

DAY 7 – FRI 5 JUNE

Garden Tomb, Ein Gedi, Qumran, Dead Sea

Today we will proceed to the Garden Tomb to celebrate Communion together. We will see that the Tomb is empty because He is indeed Risen. We will then continue to the Dead Sea, stopping first at Qumran, where the most important archaeological discovery in modern history was found, the Dead Sea Scrolls. We then proceed to Ein Gedi, the oasis in the desert that was so important to King David and his men when hiding from King Saul. Later we will check into our Dead Sea Hotel with time to enjoy their wonderful spa and pools. Overnight at the Dead Sea. (B,D)

DAY 8: SAT 6 JUNE

Masada, Beit Shean, Yardenit

Today we will cover some incredible history, beginning with King Herod's mountain fortress of Masada. We will then leave the Dead Sea and drive through the Jordan River Valley to Beit Shean, the capital city of the Decapolis, and which has incredible ruins and interesting New Covenant history. Later in the day we will drive to the Yardenit Baptismal Site on the Jordan River for those who wish to be water baptised, before heading to our hotel at the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

DAY 9: SUN 7 JUNE Sea of Galilee boat ride, Capernaum, Tabgha, Mt of Beatitudes, Magdala

Our day today will be spent around the beautiful Sea of Galilee region, starting with a sail on a wooden boat reflecting how it must have been like 2000 years ago. Afterwards, we will visit the 1st century fishing boat at Nof Ginosar, and following this we will visit Capernaum, Yeshua's home-town during the majority of His ministry years. We will then visit the Primacy of Peter, on the shores of the Sea of Galilee followed by a visit to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Yeshua preached the Sermon on the Mount. After a delicious St. Peters fish lunch (included) we will head to Magdala. This unique site has a 1st century synagogue, which we can confidently say that Yeshua taught at. It also has fascinating archaeological remains, which consists of shops, a marketplace and residential areas. We return to our hotel at the Galilee for dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)

**DAY 10: MON 8 JUNE
Banias, Golan Heights, Mt Bental**

After breakfast, we will head north to Tel Dan, which was one of two sites where idolatry was established by King Jeroboam. Next stop is Banias (Caesarea Philippi), where Yeshua asked His disciples an incredibly important question. We then make our way through the Golan Heights, an area particularly important and strategic for Israel's safety and security. Later in the day we will ascend Mt Bental for a spectacular view of the Golan area. We then drive back to the hotel at the Galilee for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

**DAY 11: MON 9 JUNE
Meggido, Mt Carmel, Caesarea, Depart Israel**

Our last day in the Land. After a wonderful breakfast we will head towards Tel Megiddo with its wonderful Canaanite Gate and vast

archaeological history. We will then proceed to Mt Carmel where Elijah performed great exploits against the prophets of Baal. At Caesarea Maritima we will see one of Israel's largest national parks with its spectacular ruins which includes a harbour, theatre and aqueduct. We will conclude our day with a farewell dinner to talk about our experiences before we proceed to the airport for our flight home. (B,D)
